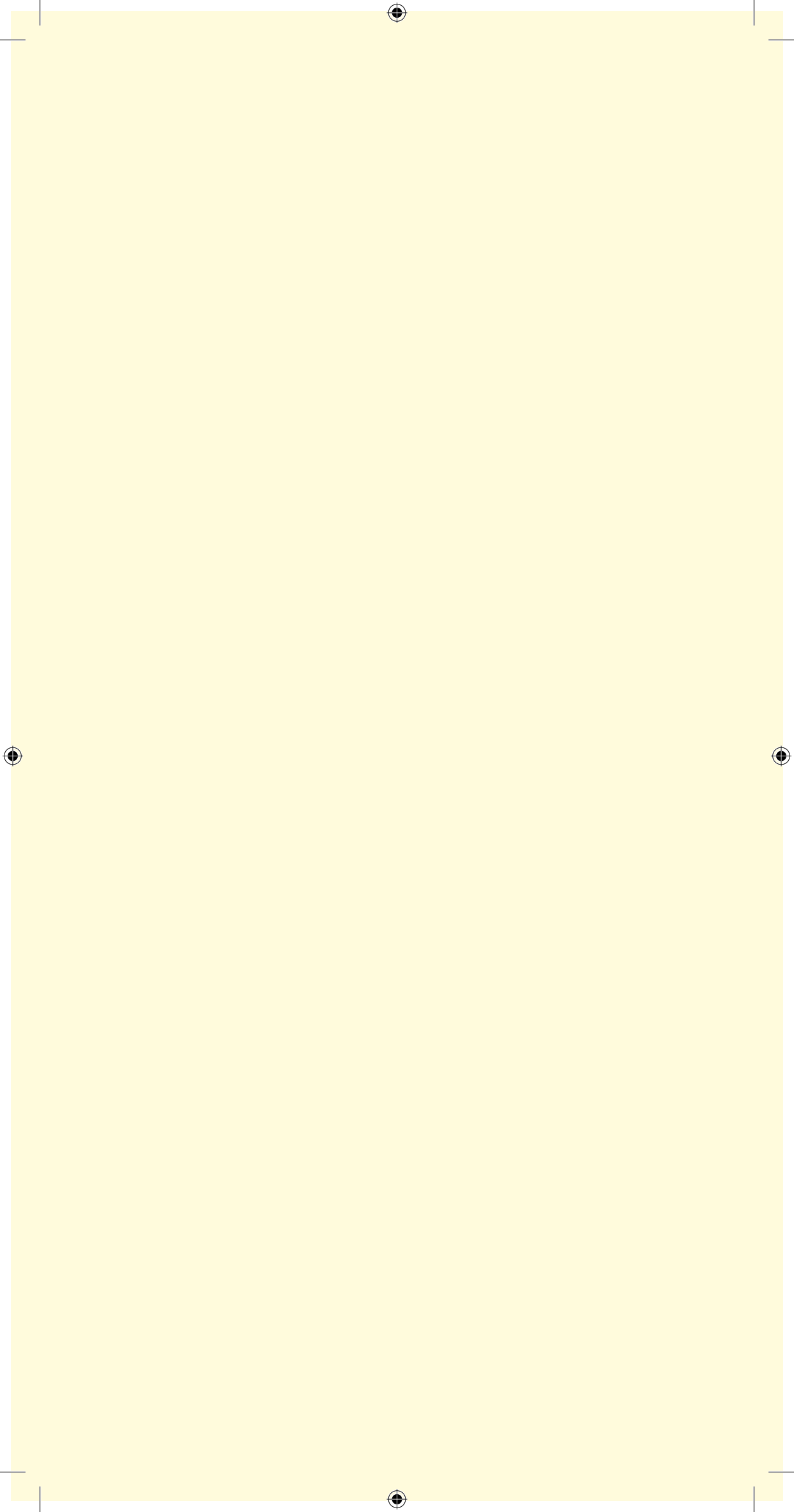

| 3 | <b>Louis Dornier et Fils Brut NV</b><br><b>Champagne 12%</b><br> A light, fresh, vigorously youthful Champagne with a fine, elegant, slightly lemony nose, lively mousse and long, crisp palate. | £28.95 |
| 4 | <b>Piper-Heidsieck Brut NV</b><br><b>Champagne 12%</b><br> Young, lively fruit flavours, a fresh, vivid aroma and assertive crispness characterise this vivacious Champagne.                    | £38.95 |

- 8 Airén Blanco, Arium Albali 2010** £14.95  
**Valdepeñas, Spain 12%** £5.20  
 Peachy and very soft with notes of Lychee and pineapple. £3.95
- 9 Pinot Grigio, Corte Vigna 2010** £15.95  
**Pavia, Italy 12%** £5.45  
 Floral, racy and dry with green, crisp fruit, an innovative wine by a collaboration of private land owners. £4.25
- 10 Sauvignon Blanc, Los Romeros 2010** £15.95  
**Central Valley, Chile 12.5%**  
 Fragrant aromas of lemon and gooseberries with a zesty finish.
- 11 Chardonnay-Semillon, Hardys The Riddle 2011** £16.95  
**SE Australia 12.5%**  
 A popular blend, combining a soft creamy texture with lime flavours and subtle oak characters that deliver a crisp dry white wine.
- 13 Marsanne-Viognier, Rare Vineyards 2009** £19.50  
**Pays d'Oc, France 12.5%**  
 Soft and aromatic with notes of peach blossom and citrus on the deliciously refreshing finish.
- 14 Mâcon-Villages Domaine de la Grange Magnien, Louis Jadot 2009, France 13%** £21.00  
 Excellent softer style of Burgundy. Fresh, full flavoured with pleasant citrus and buttery undertones.
- 15 Cortese, Gavi di Gavi La Toledana, Domini Villa Lanata 2009, Italy 12%** £24.00  
 This excellent producer crafts this refreshing gooseberry and mineral style with delicate floral hints, dry but not austere.

## RED WINE

- 19 **Arium Tempranillo-Garnacha Tinto Albali 2010** £14.95  
**Valdepeñas, Spain 12.5%** £5.20  
 Cherry-red, very smooth with blackberry and plum fruit: the tannins are light and finish soft. £3.95
- 20 **Cabernet-Merlot, Hardys The Riddle** £16.95  
**SE Australia 14%**  
 The velvety character of the Merlot complements the more structured Cabernet Sauvignon. Easy-drinking with soft tannins, a lingering finish and a light oak influence.
- 21 **Grenache, Côtes du Rhône, La Dentelière 2009** £17.95  
**France 13%**  
 The warmth and sunshine of the Rhône Valley encourages the ripe berry style with pepper hints. Easy-drinking and medium-bodied.
- 22 **Rioja, Marqués de Morano Tinto 2008** £18.50  
**Spain 13%** £4.50  
 A lighter style for Rioja, just a hint of traditional oakiness and abundant juicy ripe berries. £3.50
- 23 **Mâcon Rouge, Louis Jadot 2009** £21.50  
**France 12.5%**  
 The vibrant Gamay grape exudes sumptuous strawberry freshness and a delightful summer day wistfulness.
- 24 **Pinotage, Flagstone Writer's Block 2008** £23.95  
**Western Cape, South Africa 14.5%**  
 Intense concentrated aromas of wild blueberry and ripe cherry, supported by smoky, spicy undertones: ripe and generous: blackberry and plum flavours.
- 25 **Pinot Noir, Vidal 2009** £25.95  
**Hawke's Bay, New Zealand 13.5%**  
 Raspberry sweetness showing through a youthful character, yet more structure and complexity developing from barrique-ageing.

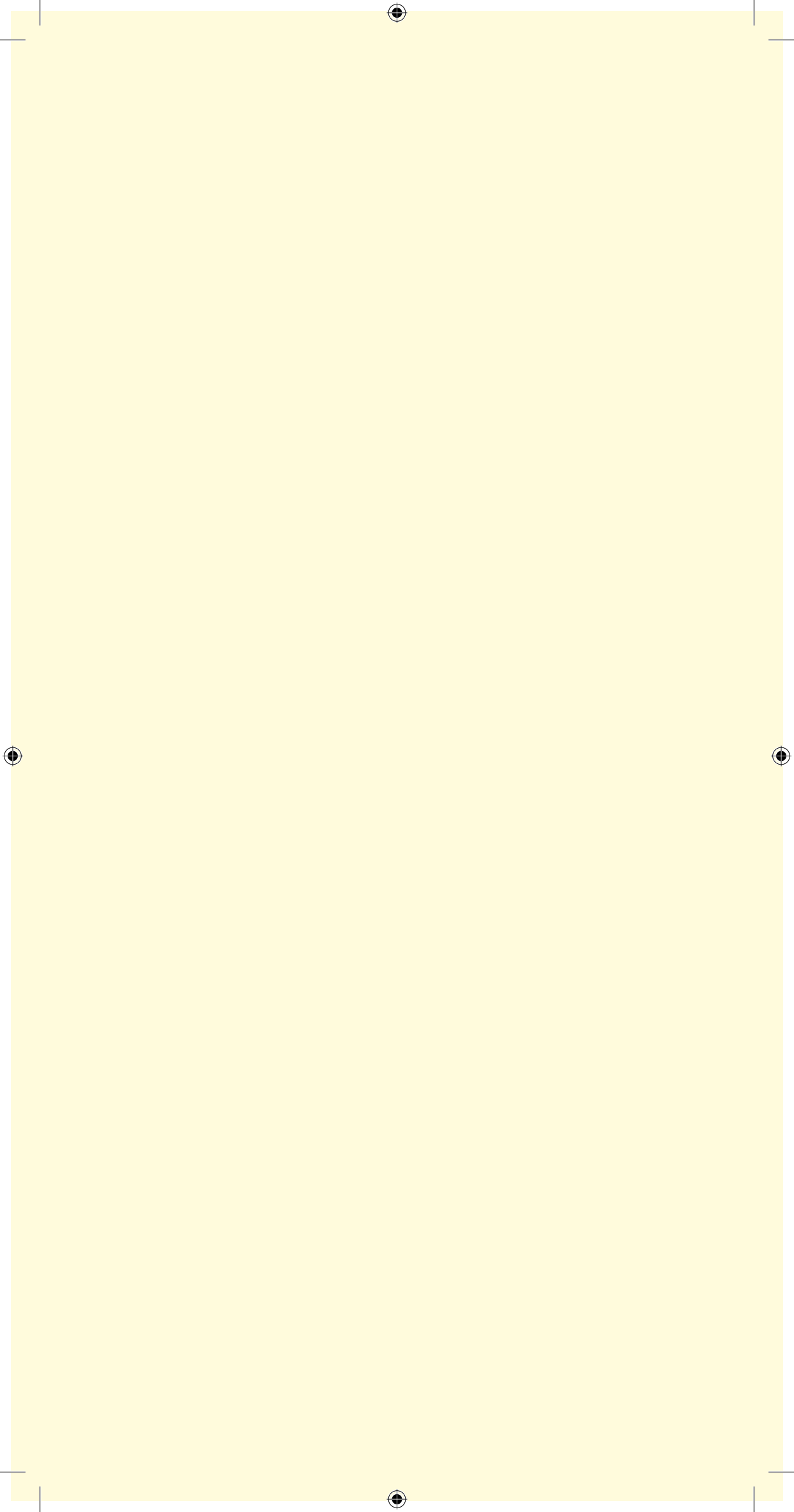
- 16 **Arium Tempranillo-Garnacha Rosado Albali 2010** £14.95  
**Valdepeñas, Spain 12%** £5.20  
 Salmon-pink with red highlights, a soft and fruity rosé showing notes of strawberry jam and citrus on the finish. £3.95
- 17 **White Zinfandel, Whispering Hills 2010** £15.95  
**California, USA 11%** £5.45  
 Loads of fresh summer-fruit flavours and lively acidity. Medium bodied to appeal to most palates, California's own Zinfandel. £4.25
- 18 **Mâcon Rosé, Louis Jadot 2009** £18.95  
**France 12.5%**  
 Deliciously dry and fruity: Gamay grapes from the Côte Mâconnais brim with red berry flavours and a crisp freshness.
